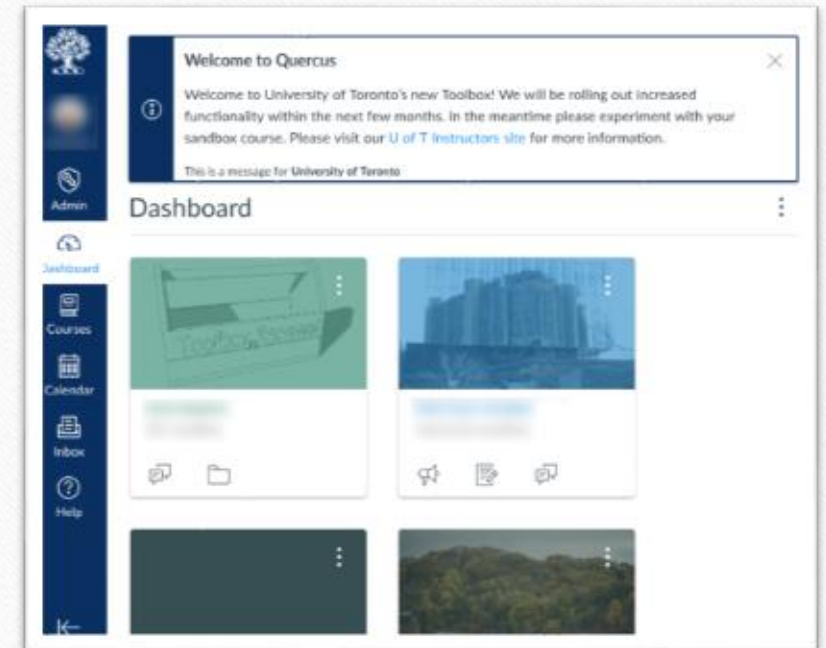
Build anew or import content while the Portal is available for comparison.

 - Mobile app, Accessible Grades Tool, Easy Calendar



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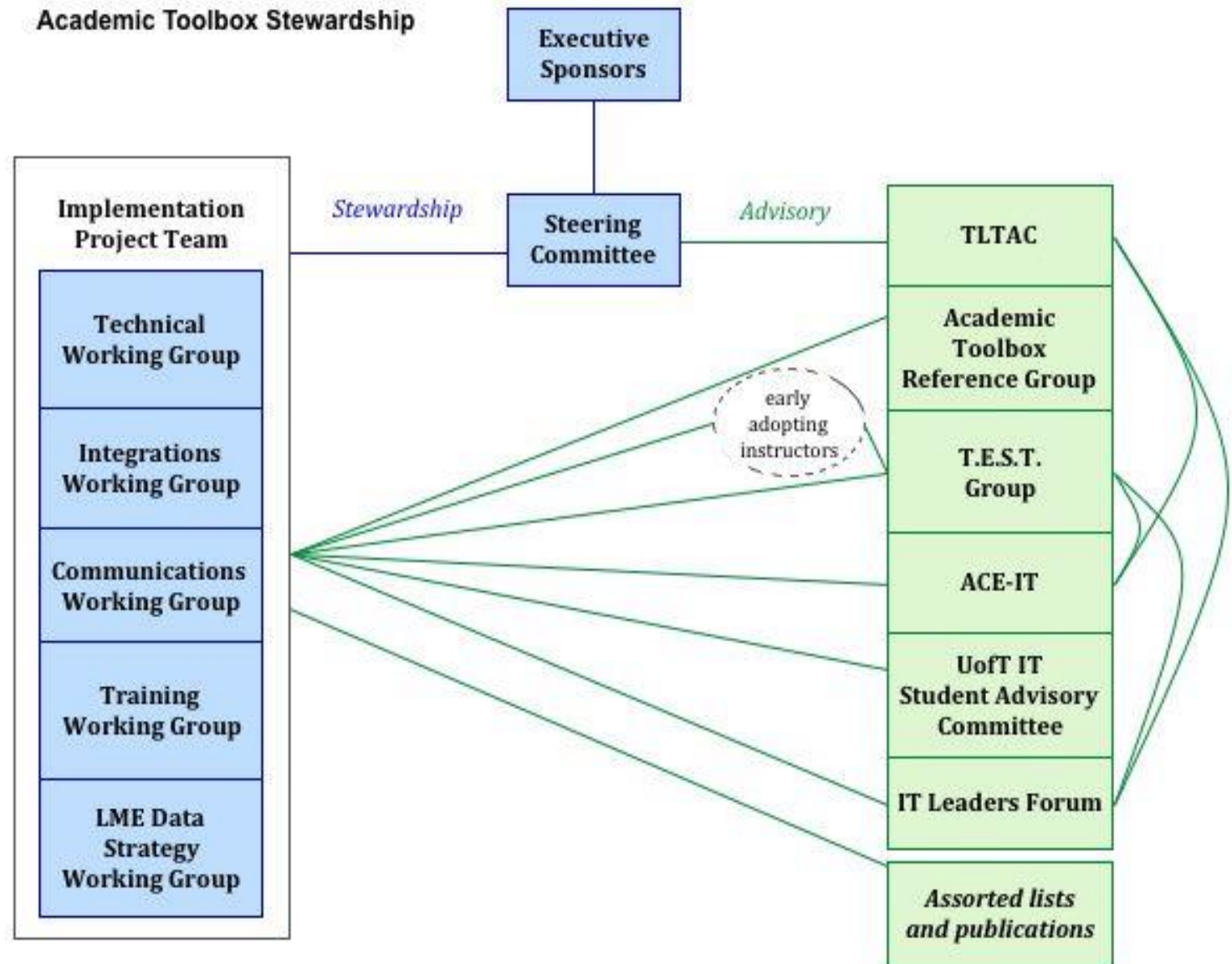
